


Don't panic !! There is a lot of confusion about this, there are rumours that it has been "dropped", rumours that you have to retake the test etc, so for clarity, here are some details !

AUTHORISATION– This is **renewed** every 5 years. It covers the **BUSINESS**.

SEE OVER. THIS MAY BE THE E MAIL YOU RECEIVE THIS YEAR

Your certificate is for **YOU**.
You can then transport under a different authorisation if you change jobs

CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCE –
This is the **TEST** you did, it is valid for life. It does **NOT** need to be redone.



BUT.....

For the first time, the authorisation renewal requires the **details of the people who hold the certificates**. And this is what is causing the confusion. Its never been asked for before.

AND, there has been confusing advice stating that there will be NO automatic renewals, and you will have to renew online. However several people, including us, have had e mail notification for renewal.

Can't find your certificate?

You usually have to show it for farm assurance, so is it there?

If you really cant dig it up, (and you did it with us,) we will have a copy, but we will need the invoice number or date at least, and we will need a week, as they are all in archive boxes GOING BACK FOR 10 YRS !

Haven't done your test?

We are running sessions pretty regularly, takes about 2.5 hrs.

It is **not** eligible for Farming Connect funding, so no need to wait for windows.

THE LEGISLATION CAME IN **2007.**

Authorisation

History:

It required every BUSINESS to register for an AUTHORISATION to transport animals .

It was granted automatically if the business did not have animal welfare convictions recorded.

This authorisation looked like a letter, and was issued by the

STATE VETERINARY SERVICE- SVS.

It has to be renewed every 5 yrs, so majority that registered in 2007, would have had to renew in 2012, it still looked like a letter, but now

issued by **ANIMAL HEALTH.**

Same people- different name.

And now the majority that started in 2007, renewed in 2012, are due to renew in 2017. This new renewal is now issued by

ANIMAL AND PLANT HEALTH

AUTHORITY. APHA

Same people- different name plus a few plant scientists.

And they now want certificate details.
